



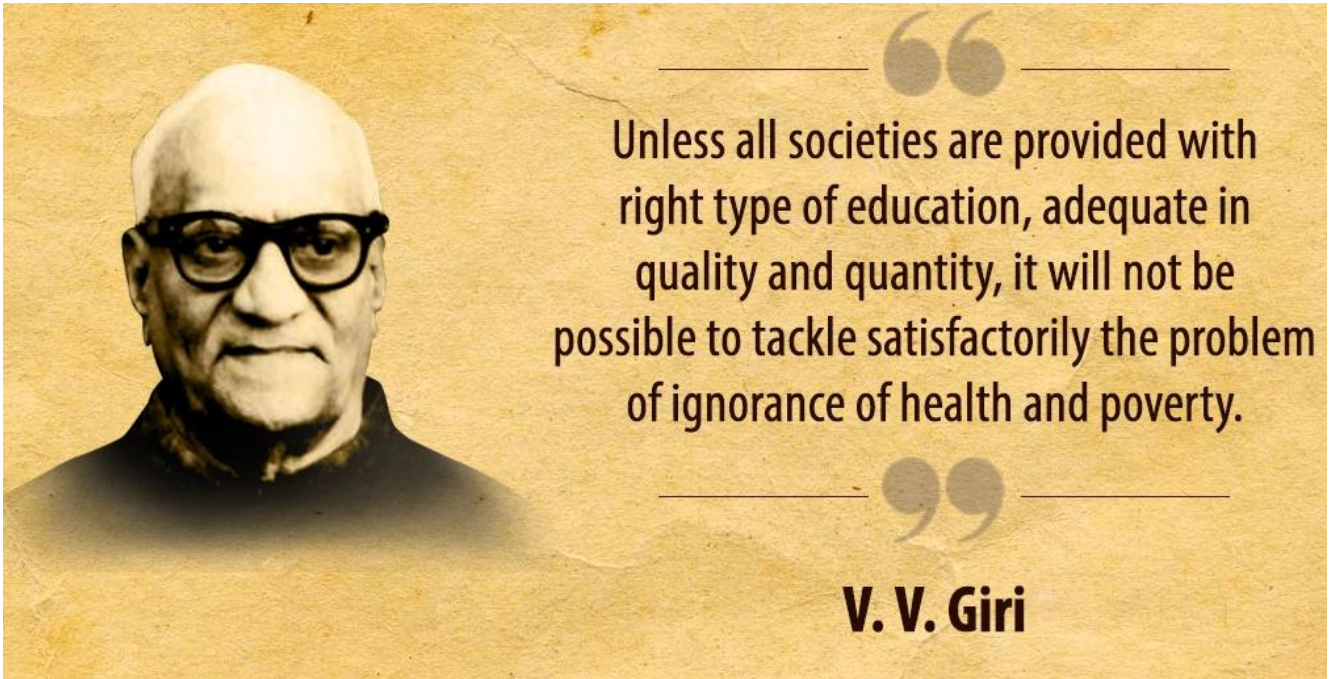
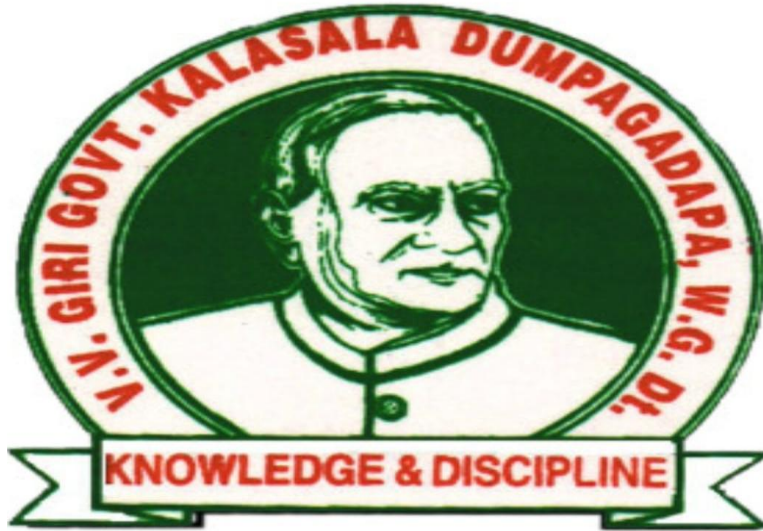

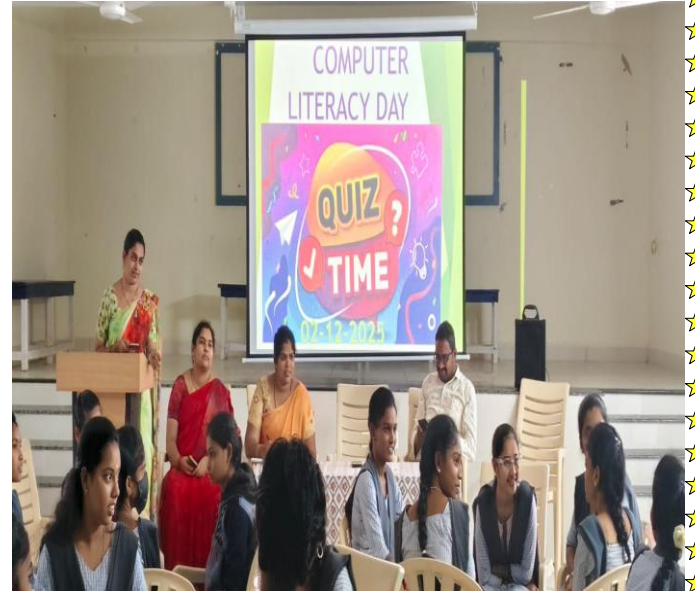
2. SKILL CONVOCATION

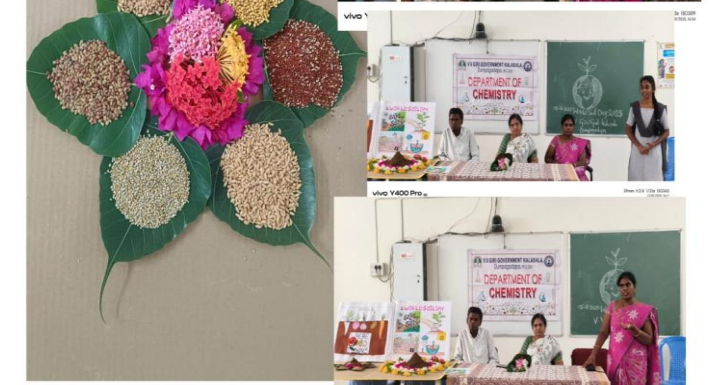
3.COMPUTER LITERACY DAY

4. WORLD SOIL DAY

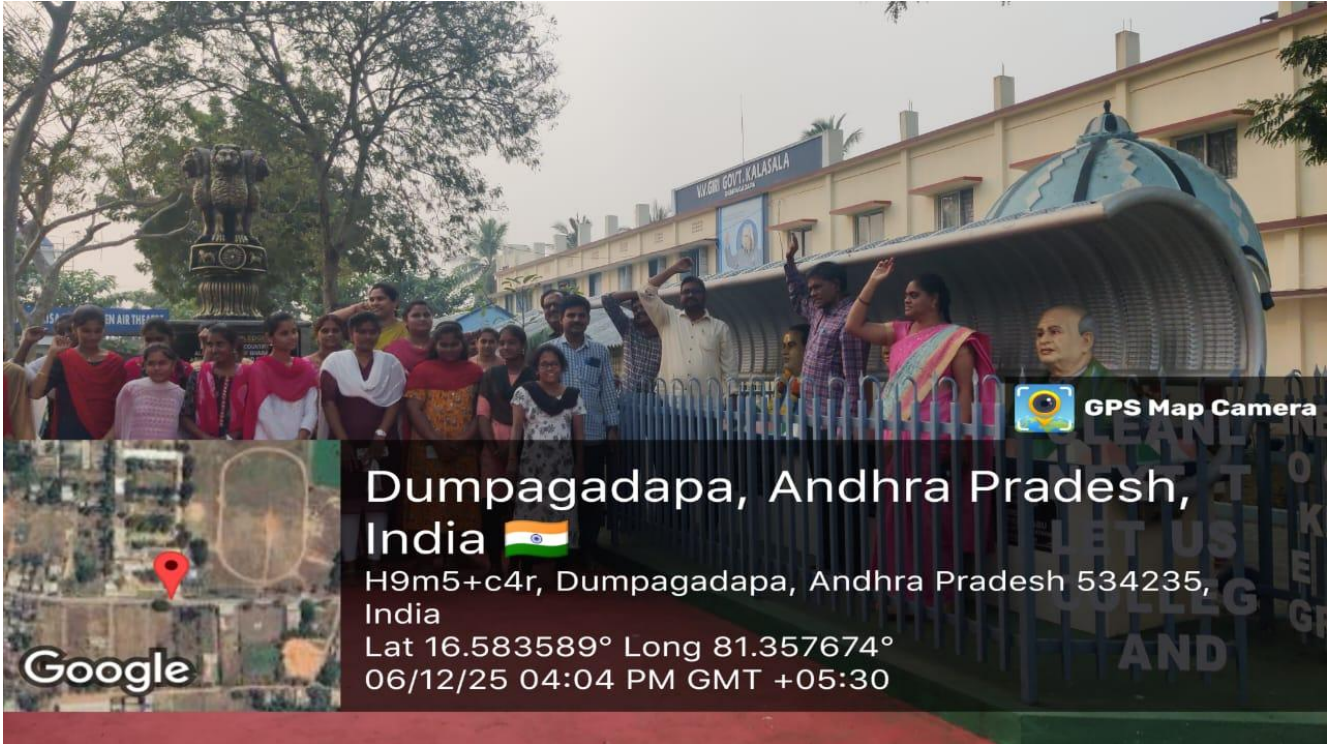

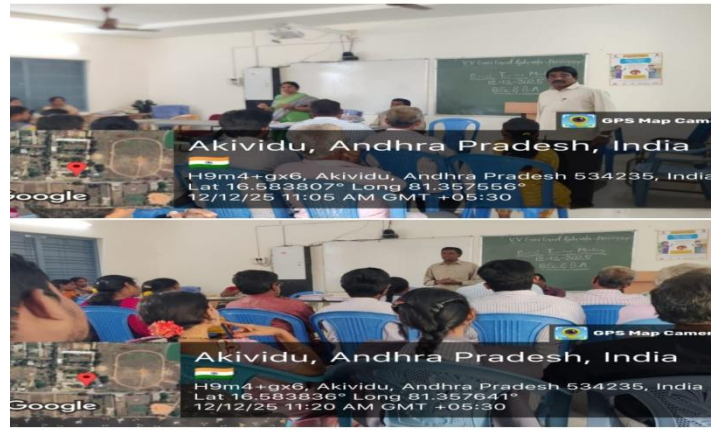
7.HUMAN RIGHT'S DAY
