



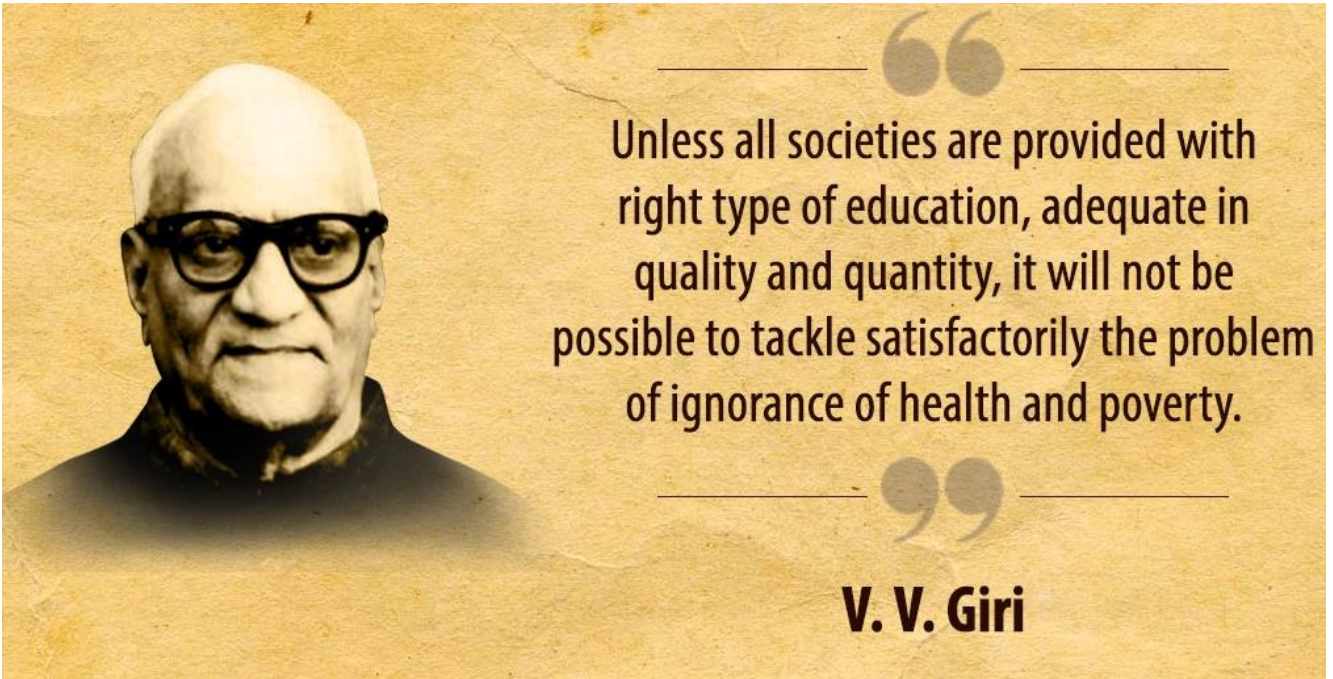
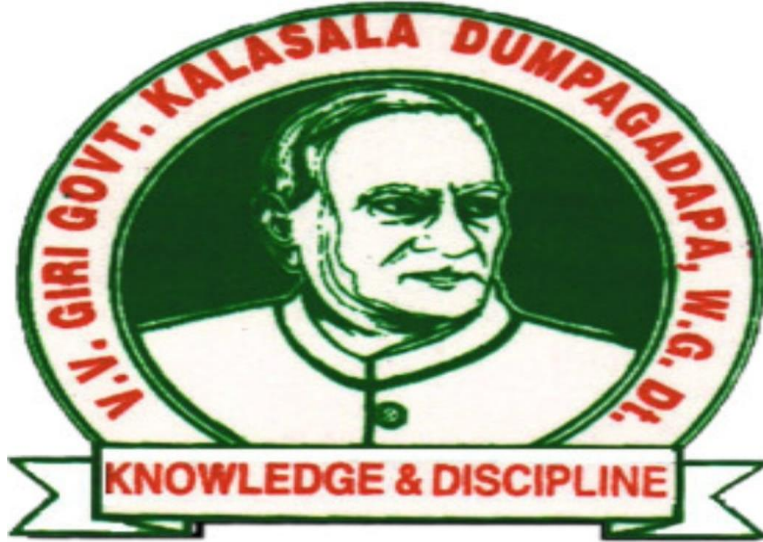

International Mother Language Day:



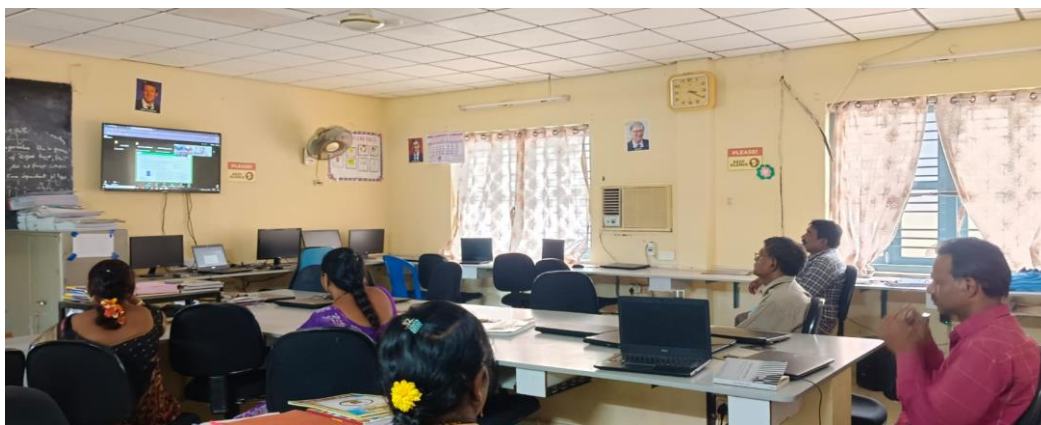
Report :
