



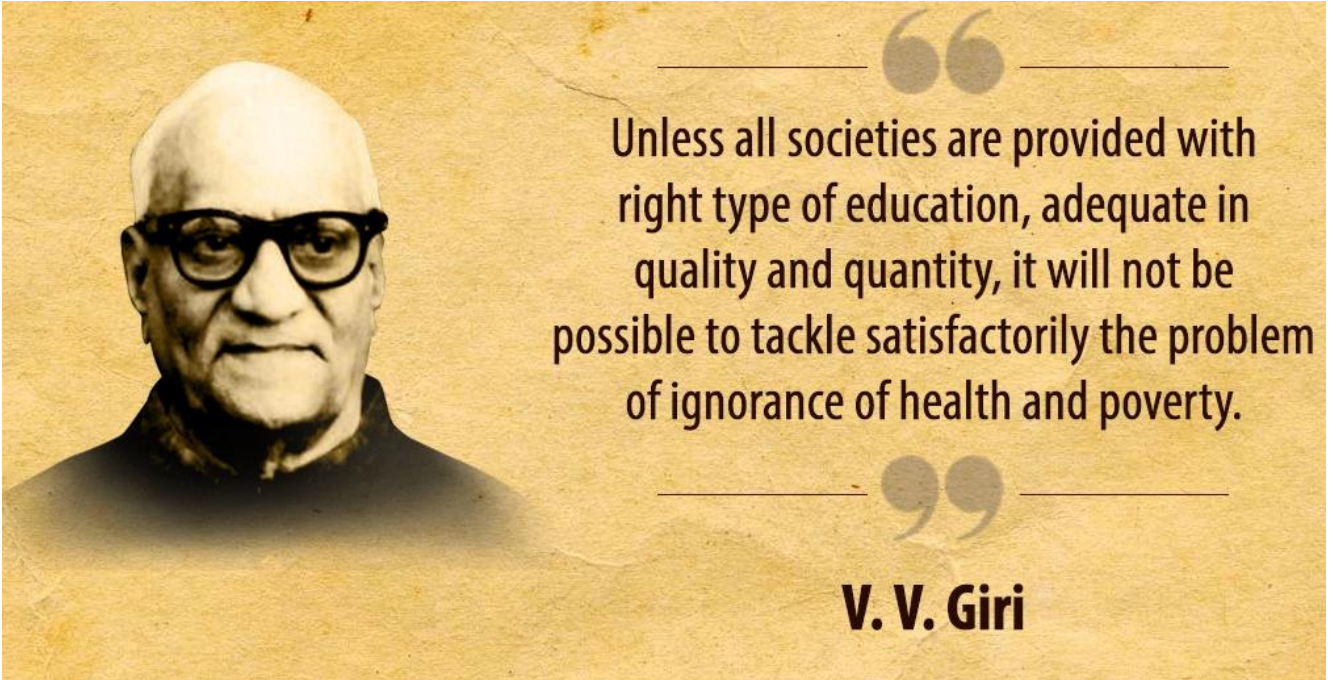
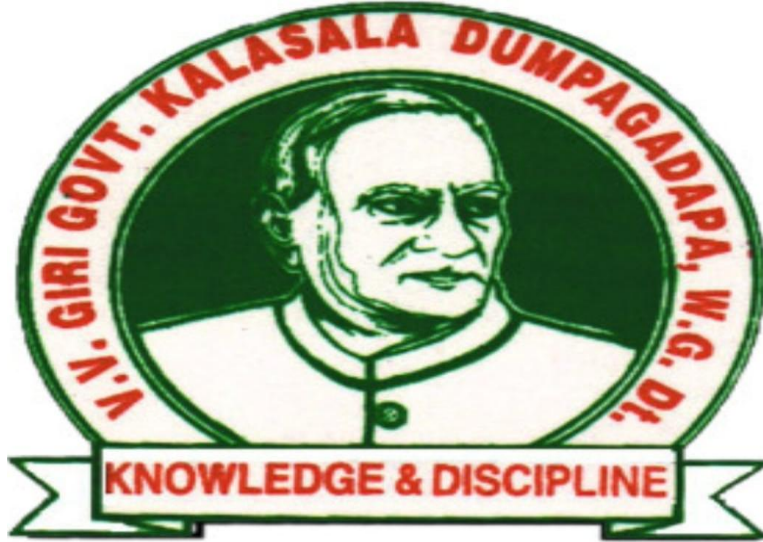

**5.VANDEMATARAM 150 YEARS :**



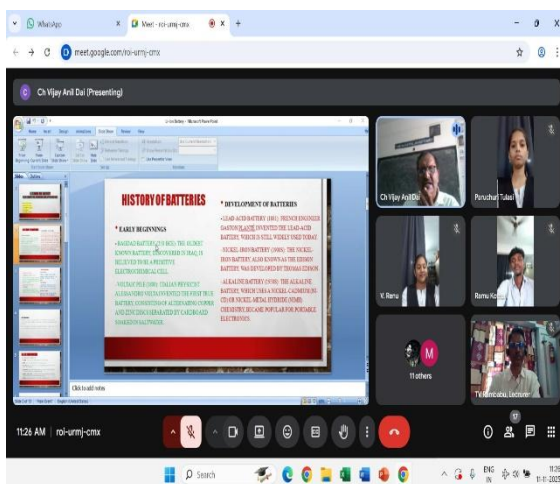
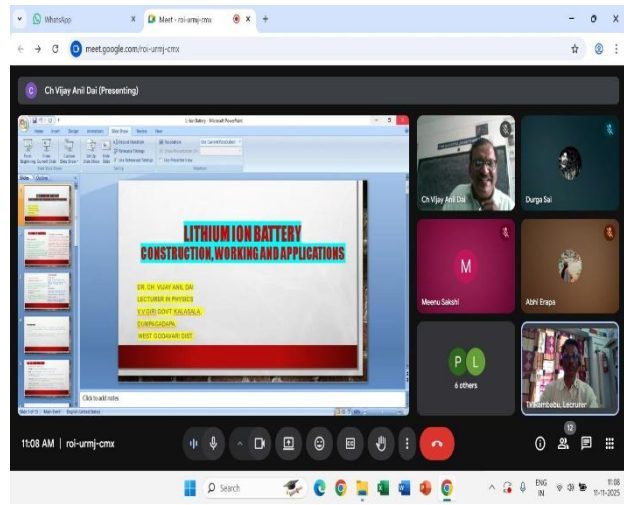
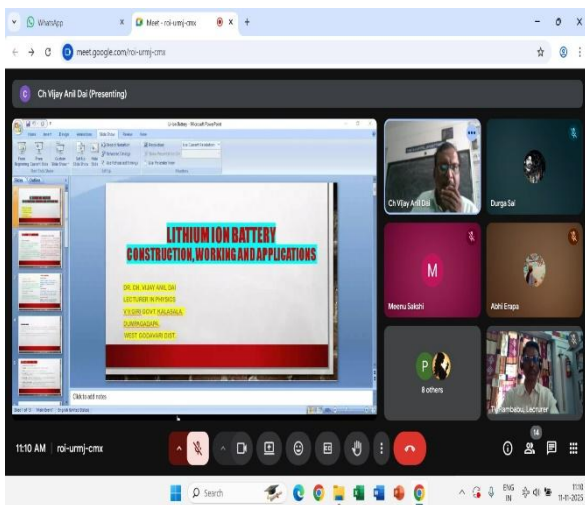
Report :

## 6. Online Guest Lecture-Physics :

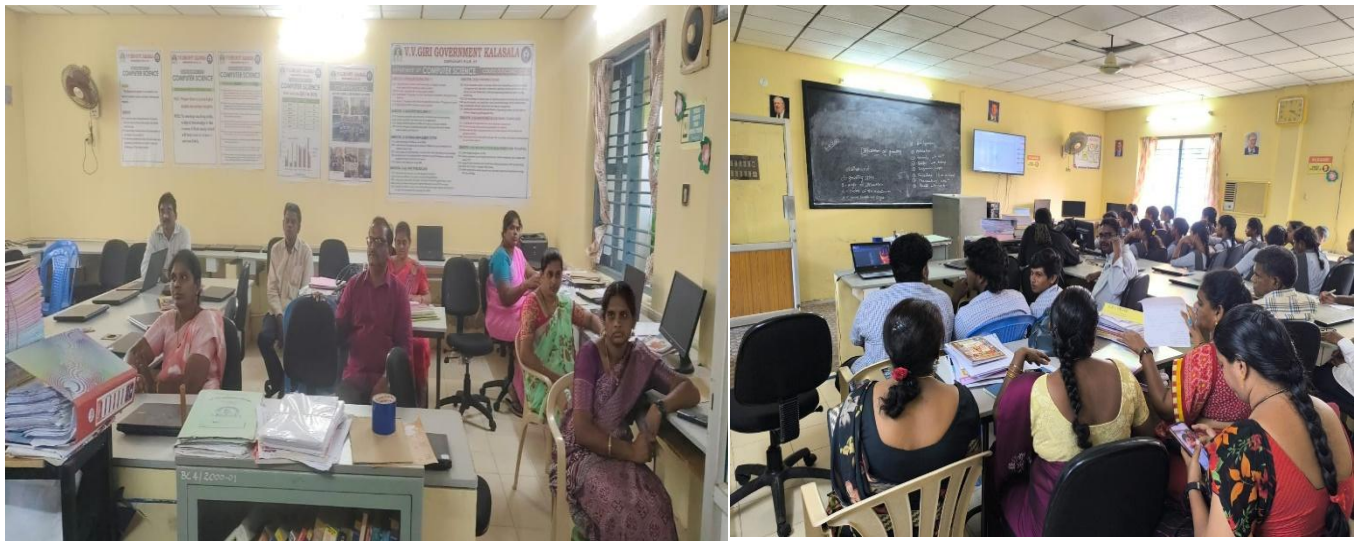
