
As per the Review meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> May 2021 with Spl. Chief Secretary to the Government of Karnataka,


Discussion and Resolution.







Also taking into the admissions from the past three years in B.A, they resolved to






send requisition to restrict the intake capacity of
